Named after Polaire, the "Pole Star" of Parisian cabaret, this cocktail embodies her magnetic allure and rebellious spirit.

Famed for her impossibly tiny waist and exaggerated hourglass figure, she defied beauty standards and captivated audiences with her fierce, unpredictable energy.

Inspired by La Goulue, the fiery and fearless star of the Moulin Rouge, this cocktail pays tribute to the woman who brought the can-can to life. Her signature high kicks and bold presence made her an icon of the Belle Époque. This drink captures that same spirit - vibrant, bold, and full of energy, just like the woman who forever changed the cabaret scene.

THE DAMIA DRAMA 13.75


CASAMIGOS BLANCO TEQUILA PINK PEPPERCORN CORDIAL STRAWBERRY • LIME JUICE

Inspired by Damia, the "tragedy queen" of French chanson, this cocktail is as intense and mesmerising as her performances. Known for her haunting ballads and dramatic stage presence, Damia sang with raw emotion, often dressed in black, bathed in a single spotlight. She was one of the first to truly embody the chanson réaliste style, paving the way for Edith Piaf.

Gaby's seductive, yet sophisticated moves revolutionised European cabaret, and the Gaby Glide mirrors that fluid, captivating style - smooth, playful, and unforgettable.
